Links issue in PDFs, Why some links don't work?

Not Recommended:

URL texts like www.dearflip.com are just text! Though they are converted to Link automatically by some PDF readers. These don't work in all PDF readers.

Result:

Won't Work in Adobe Reader Mobile, Mozilla Firefox PDF Reader

Works in Adobe Reader(if setting is on), Chrome Desktop PDF Reader

URL texts like www.dearflip.com are just text readers.

In Adobe Reader, it only shows a cursor icon (Hand cursor), indicating that it's not a proper Web Link inside the PDF, but it was converted.

Recommended:

Links like <u>www.dearflip.com#actual_link</u> **are actually are links!** Since they are defined directly in the PDF and will work in every PDF reader.

Result:

Works in Adobe Reader, Chrome Desktop PDF Reader, Adobe Reader Mobile, Mozilla Firefox PDF Reader

Links like <u>www.dearflip.com#actual_link</u> are actuwork in every PDF reader.

In Adobe Reader, it shows a **proper Web Link icon (Hand cursor with [W] inside it)**, indicating that it's a proper Web Link existing inside the PDF.

How to check?

Adobe Reader:

Adobe Reader converts URLs to link automatically by default. This feature gives an impression that the URLs are actually working while they are not actually a link in PDF.

Turn off Auto link conversion in Adobe PDF reader.
